Executive Session:

Sanibel Community Center encouraged us to drop the Silver Sneakers program. They said to run a report for the month and the individual enrollee submits it themselves instead of us doing it. We can make more money this way. At this point the program is making minimal.

A check for \$100K was released and came in today. The motion to release the remaining unrestricted balance of \$130K and was approved by a quorum.
