BY THE NUMBERS (AND COLORS)

During fiscal year 2019 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020) the generous people of Anna Maria Island and our friends from around the world made \$382,490 in unrestricted donations

to The Center.

We thank our new donors, sponsors, event attendees and endowment contributors whose gifts raise our total fundraising revenues to \$447,516

Total donors for The Center in FY2020 was 389. Of that total, 132 were new donors!

Our **Go Green Annual Fund Campaign**, motivated by **Philippe Cousteau**, helped us surpass our Phase 1 Campaign goal of **\$130,000** by January 15, 2020.

Our Go Green donors who supported the Mini-Reef Initiative helped distribute 136 reefs that annually are filtering 1.5 billion gallons of water, and growing 40,800 fish and 27,200 crabs that will move from our back canals out into the Gulf of Mexico.

During March and April, 2020 our #StayHome #BeTheOne COVID 19 video campaign featured **21** entertaining community generated videos which had **over 30,000** views bringing The Center community together to raise over **\$85,000** for The Center during the **Community Foundation of Sarasota's Giving Challenge 2020**, April 28-29, 2020.




