



**Half Send Divisions (Photo Catch & Release):**

- **Redfish Category** (can submit a total of 3 separate fish—the boat team with the most points will be the winner of the Redfish Division. In the event of a tie, the team that submitted the first fish to iAngler will be the winner.): Longest redfish within slot (one point per inch), longest redfish overall (one point per inch), redfish with one spot on each side (in honor of the first annual Full Send Fishing Tournament— (ten points awarded for this catch)
- **Snook Category** (can submit a total of 3 separate fish—the boat team with the most points will be the winner of the Snook Division. In the event of a tie, the team that submitted the first fish to iAngler will be the winner.): Longest snook within slot (one point per inch), longest snook overall (one point per inch), first snook caught of the day regardless of size (ten points awarded for this catch)
- **Trout Category** (can submit a total of 3 separate fish—the boat team with the most points will be the winner of the Trout Division. In the event of a tie, the team that submitted the first fish to iAngler will be the winner.): Longest trout within slot (one point per inch), longest trout overall (one point per inch), first trout caught of the day regardless of size (ten points awarded for this catch).
- **Flounder Category** (can submit a total of 3 separate fish): “Pancake Stack” - widest flounder (width measurement—one point awarded per inch), “Last-Minute Flattie” - Longest flounder weighed in during the final 30 minutes, 11:30am-noon, of the tournament (time stamped photo must be uploaded to iAngler, and is awarded ten points per inch), “Flounder Whisperer” - Most flounder caught (not total inches—2 points per fish awarded).

- **Billfish Category** (The team with the most points will win this category)

Billfish including Sailfish, Marlin (Blue and White), Swordfish (must be legal size)

2 Billfish Max (No Marlin and No Sailfish Allowed at Weigh-In)

Points Per Fish: 100

Swordfish will earn points per fish and 1 point for each pound at weigh-in

Marlin will earn points per fish. Any team that tags a sailfish (tags can be purchased for \$10 per tag at the Captain's Party) will earn an additional 25 points for their photo-release entry.

- **Permnato Category** (can submit a total of 3 separate fish. The team with the most points, will win "The Golden Permit Award")
  1. Closest to 20.26 lbs Category (each pound is worth one point)
  2. "We Actually Caught One" Category (smallest legal-size permit weighed in. Each pound is worth one point)
  3. "Light Weight Heavyweight Champion" Category (any permit that weighs less than 25 pounds will be worth double its weight. For example, an 18-pound permit will be counted as a 36-pound fish. So, the total points earned would be 36).
